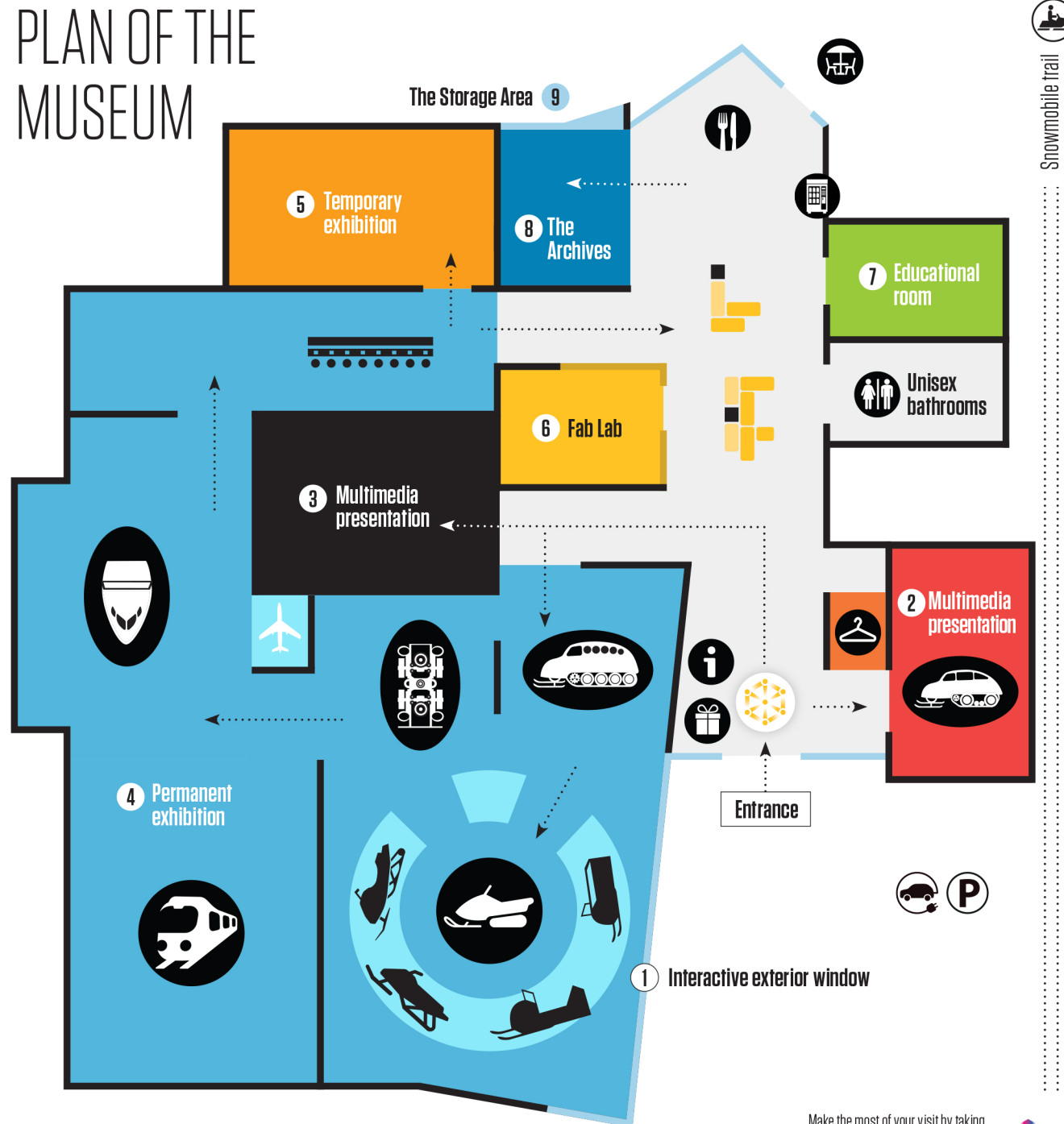

These documents, images, videos, and objects come from private archives and attest to the accomplishments and decisions that marked the life of Joseph-Armand Bombardier and his business ventures and successors.

9 The Storage Area: A Glance at the Collection

The storage area is a safe place with controlled temperature and humidity levels, to safeguard objects from the collection that houses more than 3,000 artefacts dating from the 1920s to the present day.

A large picture window lets you peek in at some of the key objects in the collection.

Note: Visitors can take photographs in the Museum but food and drink are not permitted in the exhibition areas.
